“**Kingdom Size Love**”
Matthew 5:27-48

1. Why do you think Jesus chooses these six examples of the Law (Murder, adultery, divorce, telling the truth, retaliation and loving our enemies) to teach His point about having a higher standard of obedience to the Law than the religious leaders?
2. According to Jesus, what constitutes adultery and why (v. 27-28)?
3. What do verses 29-30 tell us about how serious Jesus takes sin? Give some example of how his imagery might practically play out.
4. How does having to swear by something or someone betray our faithfulness to live up to God's standard of truthfulness (v.33-37)?
5. How does giving up our right to retaliate or get even portray kingdom living (v.38-42)?
6. How does loving and praying for our enemies prove that we are true sons and daughters of our Father in heaven (v.43-48)?
7. **Bonus Question:** How will you or did you show kingdom size love this week?
